

Event Regulations

Definitions

Whenever reference is made to the following in this document:

1. **Regulations** – it ought to be understood as this document;
2. **Organizer** – it ought to be understood as Pamper – Grupa Testerska association;
3. **Venue** – it ought to be understood as Leśny Ośrodek Szkoleniowy w Puszczykowie, Adama Wodziczki 3, 62-040 Puszczykowo, Poland;
4. **Event** – it ought to be understood as the event called Designer Camp held on November 14-17, 2024 in the Venue, organized by the Organizer;
5. **Participant** - it ought to be understood as adults who have registered and paid for the participation in the Event;
6. **Service** - it ought to be understood as members of the Organizer, persons acting on their behalf or under their authority and undertaking activities related to the execution and organization of the Event.

Participation conditions

1. Adults who have expressed their willingness to participate and who have paid a fee in the amount specified in the Event's offer can participate in the Event.
2. Filling in the registration form is equivalent to the acceptance of the Regulations.

Organizational and Venue rules at the event area

1. The Participants of the Event and all persons who are on the premises of the Event are obliged to behave in a manner that does not threaten the safety of other people present at the Event, and in particular comply with the provisions of these Regulations, the regulations of the Venue available at <http://www.osrodek-puszczykowo.pl/> and follow the recommendations of the Organizer's representatives to ensure their safety and order.
2. It is forbidden to:
 - a. destroy devices, equipment, signs, information boards and advertising media located on the premises of the Event;
 - b. perform any activities that may pose a threat to life, health or safety of people staying on the premises of the Event;
 - c. use sanitary facilities, conference rooms and hotel rooms not in accordance with the intended purpose.

3. During the Event, it is forbidden to bring and possess:
 - a. weapons or other dangerous items,
 - b. explosives,
 - c. pyrotechnic articles,
 - d. fire hazardous materials,
 - e. narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances.
4. The Organizer, partners and sponsors of the Event are entitled to use the images, statements and personal data of individual Participants participating in the Event, while the images and data will be used in materials promoting the Event and accompanying events (press, radio, television, Internet, graphic materials). Participants are not entitled to any gratuities, in particular remuneration for the use of the image, statements and personal data of individual participants. The Participant who appears on the advertising or promotional materials has the full right to withdraw his image from the indicated materials after prior notification of this information to the Organizer by sending an e-mail to the following address: kontakt@designercamp.pl
5. The Organizer has the right to stop the Event at any time for safety reasons or refuse to participate in the Event and remove from the area of its holding any Participant who by his behavior violates the provisions of the Regulations, creates danger for other Participants or himself or his behavior hinders or prevents the course of the Event.
6. Participants have the right to record the course of the Event with the use of sound or image recording devices, including mobile phones, only for their own use, with the consent of the Organizer.

Responsibility

1. The Organizer is not responsible for the effects of Force Majeure. Force Majeure is an event beyond the control of the Organizer, which makes the performance of obligations impossible or may be considered impossible due to the existing circumstances. Force Majeure includes in particular: weather conditions, breakdowns or disruptions in the operation of devices supplying electricity, heat, light, military operations or actions of state or local authorities in the field of policy, laws and regulations affecting the performance of obligations.
2. The Organizer and the Service are not responsible for any personal, material or property damage of Participants that occur during the Event. They are not responsible for thefts and items left unattended.
3. Participants bear civil liability for all damage/harm caused by them, through

their own sole fault, to other Participants of the Event, third parties and members of the Organizer.

4. The Organizer is not responsible for any collisions, random events and accidents during the Event.
5. The Organizer does not refund the participation costs in case of partial or complete absence of a Participant.
6. The Organizer has insurance against the civil liability of the Event.

Final provisions

1. The interpretation of the Regulations belongs to the Organizer.
2. If any of the provisions of the Regulations is deemed, in whole or in part, invalid or unenforceable, then all other provisions (in whole or in part) will remain valid and enforceable.
3. In matters not covered by the Regulations, the Organizer decides.
4. In matters not covered by the Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code of the Republic of Poland shall apply.
5. Ignorance of the Regulations does not release the Participant from the rules specified by the Organizer in the above-mentioned document.
6. The Organizer reserves the right to change the Regulations at any time.
7. The Regulations come into force on the day of their announcement.

Providing personal data is voluntary, but failure to provide it will make it impossible to achieve the purpose for which it was obtained, in particular registration of participation in the Event.
